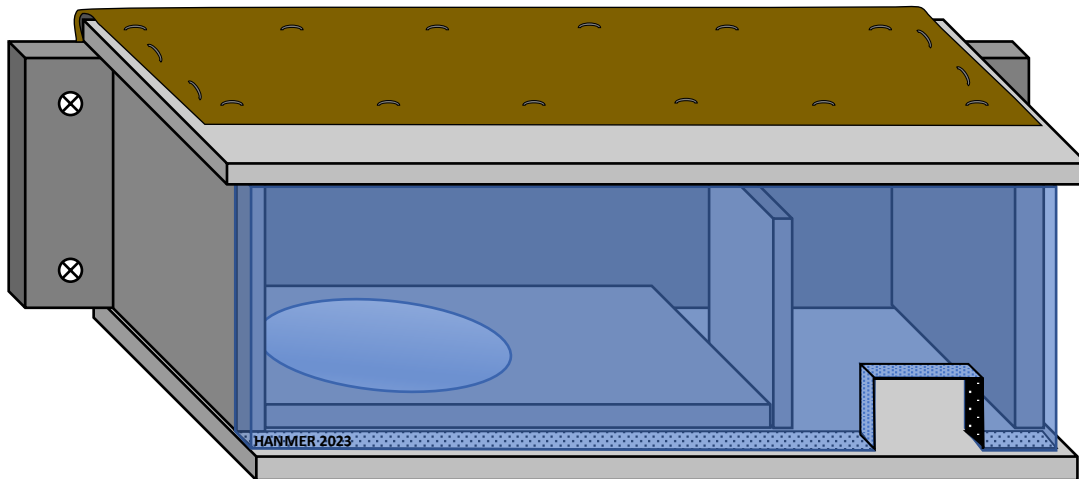


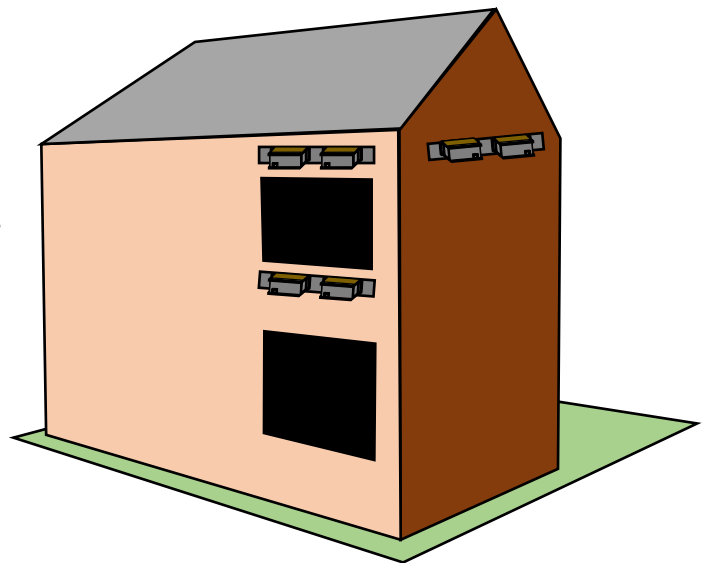
# The Northumberland Swift Box 2023 (Version 3 revised)

(Developed with the support of Alnwick Wildlife Group)

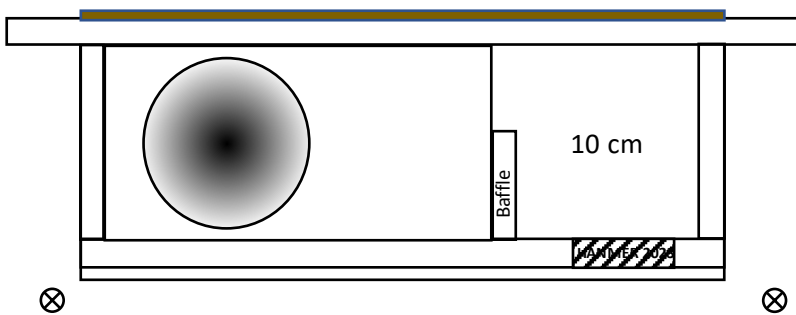


Use plank wood a minimum of 16mm thick.

Locate boxes at least 4m above the ground, with an unobstructed flight path—see possible locations on the diagram.



Plan view inside box

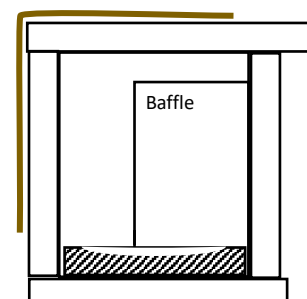


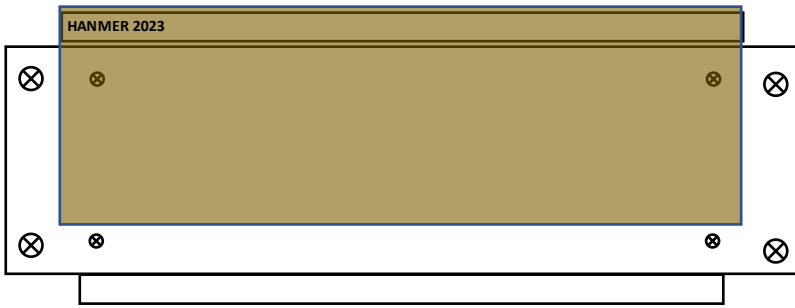
Front view



Side view

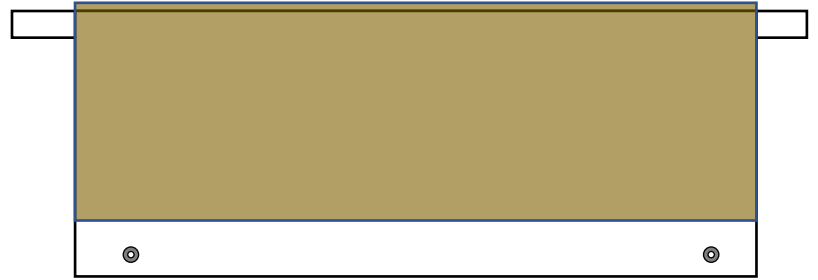
Paint the inside of the box with Black matt emulsion paint. Swifts prefer dark nesting places.



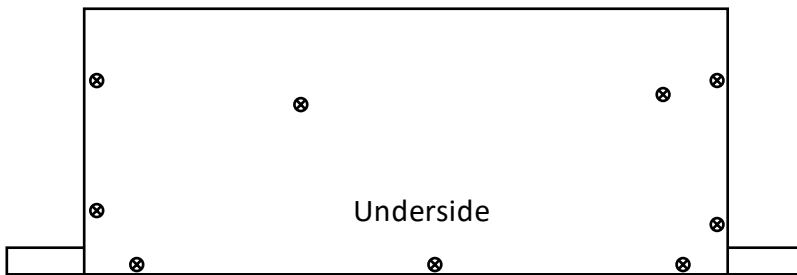


Back view

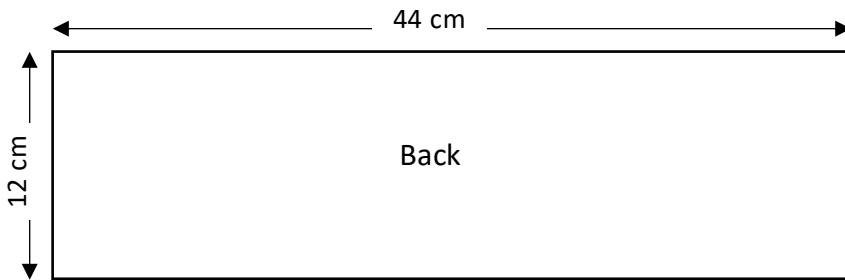
Roof flashing folded over to make a hinge.



Top view

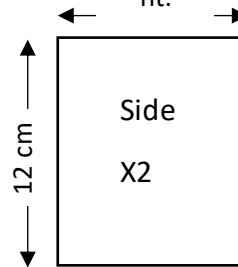

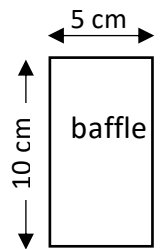

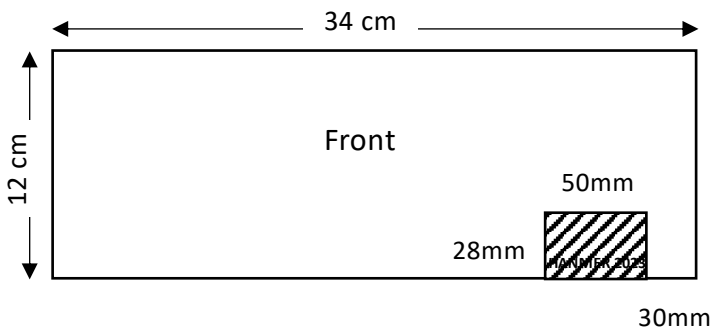
9.5 cm but cut to fit.



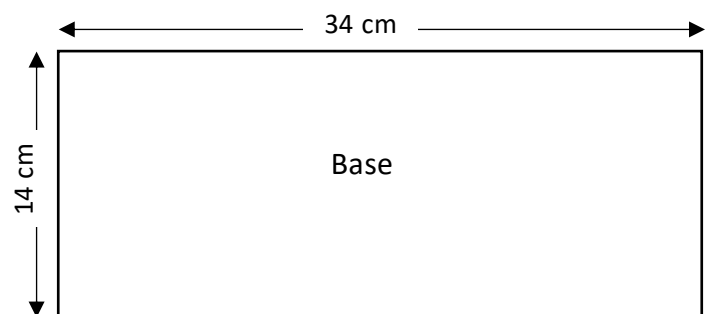

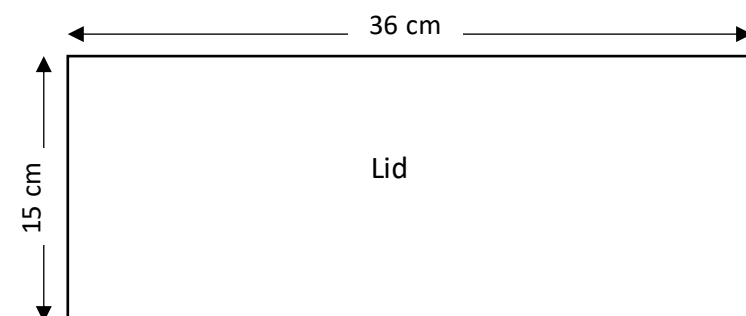

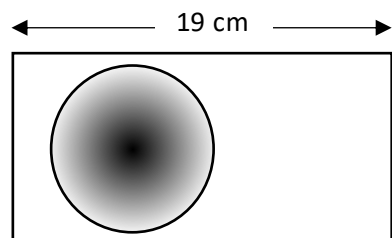
